We are so glad to be rebuilding our team and look forward to hearing from willing and qualified candidates.

[Unity Day](#) is coming up! It will be held September 5-6, 2025. This 24-hour worldwide online festival will be a joyful collaboration with members from everywhere—including you! There was more detail about this in our last eblast, and we'll be posting additional info as the event nears. Don't forget to send us photos, short (1-2 minute) video clips, shout-outs, and more. On 12 July we will host a [webinar](#) based on the Issue Discussion Topic (IDT): Disruptive and Predatory Behavior. It will be in English with translations provided in Arabic, Farsi, Hebrew, Italian, Portuguese, Russian, and Spanish; please contact us if you require other interpretation. *This topic, at its heart, is about our ability as a Fellowship to carry the message—if new members do not feel safe, they won't stay. It's also about public relations—if professionals hear negative things about NA, they will stop referring clients to us, treatment centers will go somewhere else, and addicts who need us may never find us.*

As previously stated in my report of May 2025, this is a CAR year, and the CAR survey is in the process of being created. This is the first time this

process is being implemented through a collaborative effort with all Conference Participants as well as the World Board. The previous CAR Survey was done by the board only. The CAR survey submission form was made available to all members of the fellowship through May 2025. Over 500 forms were received and compiled into five categories. Each CP (Conference Participant) who carried the conscience of their region, zonal representatives and world board members were asked to prioritize the selections in each category by choosing up to five of the ideas submitted. The following are the five categories we were asked to choose from with up to five topics each. The completed list will become the CAR Survey that will be available to the entire fellowship to vote on as well as be made available on NA.org.

New Recovery Literature:

Issue Discussion Topics

Keep in mind that the selection with the most votes will be in the Car Survey which will be available in November 2025 when the CAR comes out. As a reminder, the motions that are submitted and CAR ready by August 2025 will be in the CAR report. The CAR Survey is for new and existing recovery literature, new and existing service material and Issue Discussion Topics. The process of creating new literature and/or revising existing literature can

happen faster by utilizing the CAR Survey as what is selected can become a project plan and implementation can begin sooner.

In the past new literature that was approved through a CAR motion would then have to be included in the CAT (Conference Approval Track). The CAT shows the path and status of approved CAR motions through implementation and production. New and/or revised literature has taken anywhere from four to eight years to become a reality and that was when the CAR occurred every two years. With the current timeline of the CAR taking place every three years through 2029, we could be looking at six to ten years without this change in the literature process.

Attached to this report is the summary of decisions from the last NEZF meeting in April 2025. The RD was not in attendance, but we agreed that the former AD, Magdalena, would attend in my place. Unfortunately, Magdalena became sick and had to leave early. She was hospitalized for a few days, but she has recovered. In my report to the zone, I informed them of the result of the straw poll taken at March's region to not donate any funds to the NEZF. As noted by the policy chair, the Mid-Atlantic region has never donated any funds besides our share of the Zoom account which amounts to \$30. The zone is comprised of 15 regions and the request for each region to donate approximately \$800 per year to fund the trusted servants and the services the zone provides. The people in service at the zone have been funding themselves as they perform the tasks of their positions and the donations would help to offset the cost to each subcommittee. The budget for the zone is as follows:

The next meeting of the NEZF will be July 27, 2025, by zoom. The next in person meeting of the NEZF will be October 24-26,2025, in Newark, New Jersey. The October meeting of the NEZF is for strategic planning for the year.The rate for the room is \$149 plus tax per night.

The first event after the release of the CAR in November will be December 5-7,2025, at the Multi-Regional Learning Event (MERL) in Nashua, New Hampshire. The flyer for this event is attached to the report. The next event will be our regional event at MARLCNA XXXXI being held on Jan 16-18,2026. There will be no in person zonal event next April 2026 as the World Service Conference will be held May 3-9, 2026, in Chatsworth, CA. The World Board is in the process of planning for each delegate who will be attending. The only information available currently is the room rate, which is \$234 plus tax. More information will be available soon.

In my report of March 2025, we spoke on creating a weekly zoom meeting for anyone interested in getting more information on the CAR motions, the CAT (which is the Conference Approval Track) and the CAR Survey. The initial discussion was to work with other delegates from other regions and anyone who is interested in participating to help our areas and groups to have a better understanding of the information and thereby increasing the number of people who vote on the motions. I am asking each RCM and RCMA to forward to me the information of anyone who would like to be a part of this effort.

Lastly, there is an open webinar happening today July 12, 2025, on Disruptive and Predatory Behavior which is one of the IDT from the last CAR survey. The time is from 2:00pm-3:30pm EST and Zoom ID: 892 4425 9430 and the Passcode: 1953.

MARLCNA XXXIX Ad Hoc Committee

Good afternoon,

This is the final report of the ad hoc committee to audit MARLCNA XXXIX financials. As previously reported, we are unable to complete the audit as there are incomplete records for Registration, Merchandise and the Treasurer.

The first problem that was noted was the funds from the MARLCNA XXXVIII subcommittee was not transferred from the committee's bank account to the MARSCNA regional bank account. Per the checkbook, the checks were written and then they were voided out. By not transferring the funds back to the region, the books for MARLCNA XXXVIII were not closed for the year. The amount was \$17, 487.12.

The second issue was a check written to Deborah Goodwin for Registration package items of MARLCNA XXXVIII in the amount of \$1,900.00 ck#2385. That check did not clear the bank and was paid by MARLCNA XXXIX funds. Therefore, the actual start- up amount for MARLCNA XXXIX was not \$15,000 but \$13,100.

As a result, the hotel did not receive the \$2,000 deposit until September instead of in April as was previously done in the past. The region did not provide separate checks for the hotel deposit and the start-up funds. The purpose of these transactions is to provide transparency as it is easier to keep track of what payments are being made. The region operates on a fiscal basis and not on a calendar basis. The fiscal year is April 1 to March 31, and it is the reason why all funds for each year is deposited after April 1 and all funds except the \$400 that is held for miscellaneous expenses are transferred out before March 31<sup>st</sup> .

There are a number of adjustments that are required to be made to get a clear picture of what the proceeds from the event was for MARLCNA XXXIX:

The hotel billed for rooms at the rate of \$159.00 plus 11% occupancy tax = \$176.49

The committee received complimentary room at the rate of 1/50 occupancy for a total of 10 rooms, but the rate of comps was \$159.00 = \$1,590.00

The hotel should have comped the bill at the same rate as we were charged which would have been \$1,764.90

The difference is \$174.90

There is a pickup for \$1,360.00 registration cash that was not accounted for as well as an additional \$190.00 in comedy show tickets that were sold at the door. This increase the total amount from registration by \$1,550.00

To verify the numbers reported, the registration ledgers, spreadsheets, receipt book, Primary Purpose Packages/Newcomer donation ledger is required. Each PPP package has a banquet ticket and a breakfast ticket inside which is part of what is paid to the hotel for the meals. The amount of Newcomer donations is unknown as there is no record of how many packages were created and given away.

The committee paid for their rooms, but several people paid by check. One check was written to the hotel directly and was used to pay the hotel bill and another person paid by check to the committee and that check was deposited after the event.

The merchandise numbers are verified by the merchandise order form, the sales forms and the final inventory of the remaining merchandise. Without this information, we can't assess if the numbers are correct.

The minutes from each subcommittee meeting are an important part of the reconciliation process as it provides monthly totals for registration funds received as the planning of the event proceeds. Each subcommittee should be reporting all purchases made and providing receipts to the treasurer. It is part of the treasurer's duty to attach a receipt to the report that a check was written on.

The treasurer's report is also vital as it provides detailed information on the expenses that are incurred.

We are missing too much of this information to get a clear picture of what was made and what was reported and therefore we cannot verify the numbers as reported.

In conclusion, the recordkeeping for the money received and spent is inadequate to verify any of the totals reported. This concludes the ad hoc committee to audit the MARLCNA XXXIX financials.




